Buttons and icons

There's a lot you can do with your new device, so here's a quick glance of some basic items to get you started.

Buttons



Power key: Hold the Power key for 3 seconds to power the device on/off. When the screen is off, press the Power key to turn the screen on.

WPS key: Hold the WPS key for 3 seconds to activate the WPS function. Once activated, the Wi-Fi™ LED indicator will flash every two seconds. If the network is not accessed within 2 minutes, the device will automatically exit WPS (Wi-Fi Protected Setup) mode.

LED indicators: Display network signal, Wi-Fi, SMS, battery charge and mobile data status

First time use

Please take a look at the steps below to walk you through how to connect your hotspot:

- 1. Please refer to the back cover of your device to retrieve the Wi-Fi name (SSID) and Wi-Fi Password
 - The Wi-Fi name (SSID) will be "Coolpad Surf + the last 4 digits of IMEI"
 - o The Wi-Fi password is the last 8 digits of the device IMEI
- 2. Hold the Power key for 3 seconds until all LED indicators illuminate in blue.
- 3. Connect your Wi-Fi device to your Mobile Hotspot.
- 4. On your computer or other Wi-Fi enabled device, search for available Wi-Fi networks and select network name (SSID) located inside the back panel of your mobile hotspot.

From a Windows PC:

- Left-click Wireless Network Connection on the taskbar to view available networks.
- Choose the SSID from the list of available networks.

From a Mac computer:

- 3. Select System Preferences > Network > Airport.
- 4. Click Advanced to choose SSID from the list of available networks.
- 5. Choose the SSID from the list of available networks.

From an iOS device:

- 6. Go to **Settings > Wi-Fi.**
- 7. Choose the SSID from the available networks.

From an Android device:

- 8. Go to Settings > Wi-Fi settings.
- Choose the SSID from the available networks.
- 5. Enter the password located inside the back panel, then click **OK**.
