JOB PURPOSE

The Digital Navigation Coordinator plays a crucial role in advancing digital equity and inclusion initiatives for the Solano County connected programs and services. This role involves working closely with community members, partners, and stakeholders to ensure that individuals have equitable access to digital resources, tools, and information. The coordinator will focus on bridging the digital divide by providing support, guidance, and resources to underserved populations, ultimately empowering them to navigate and utilize digital technologies effectively. They will also act as a central resource hub and oversee projects including the Digital Navigator system to ensure programs and services are promoted and implemented throughout Solano County.

- Collaborate with local communities, organizations, and individuals to understand their specific digital needs and challenges.
- Organize workshops, seminars, and outreach programs to promote digital literacy and inclusion. Specifically organize ongoing schedule of digital literacy classes at various public institutions and organizations throughout Solano County.
- Direct Digital Navigators to programs, events, initiatives, and the implementation of workshops and classes throughout Solano County.
- Provide personalized guidance and assistance to individuals who face barriers to accessing and using digital tools. Key assist in establish tech support and the online Digital Navigation System.
- Establish data tracking and impact measurement protocols to ensure all pertinent program data is accurately captured.
- Assist community members in setting up and using digital devices, software, and online platforms.
- Conduct thorough assessments to identify digital disparities and areas where the community requires additional support.
- Gather data and insights to inform the development of targeted programs and interventions.

- Create and curate educational resources, guides, and tutorials to enhance digital skills and knowledge.
- Develop materials that address specific needs, such as online safety, basic computer literacy, and job search skills.
- Collaborate with local schools, libraries, non-profits, and government agencies to expand access to digital resources.
- Build and maintain relationships with external stakeholders to leverage resources and support for the digital equity mission.
